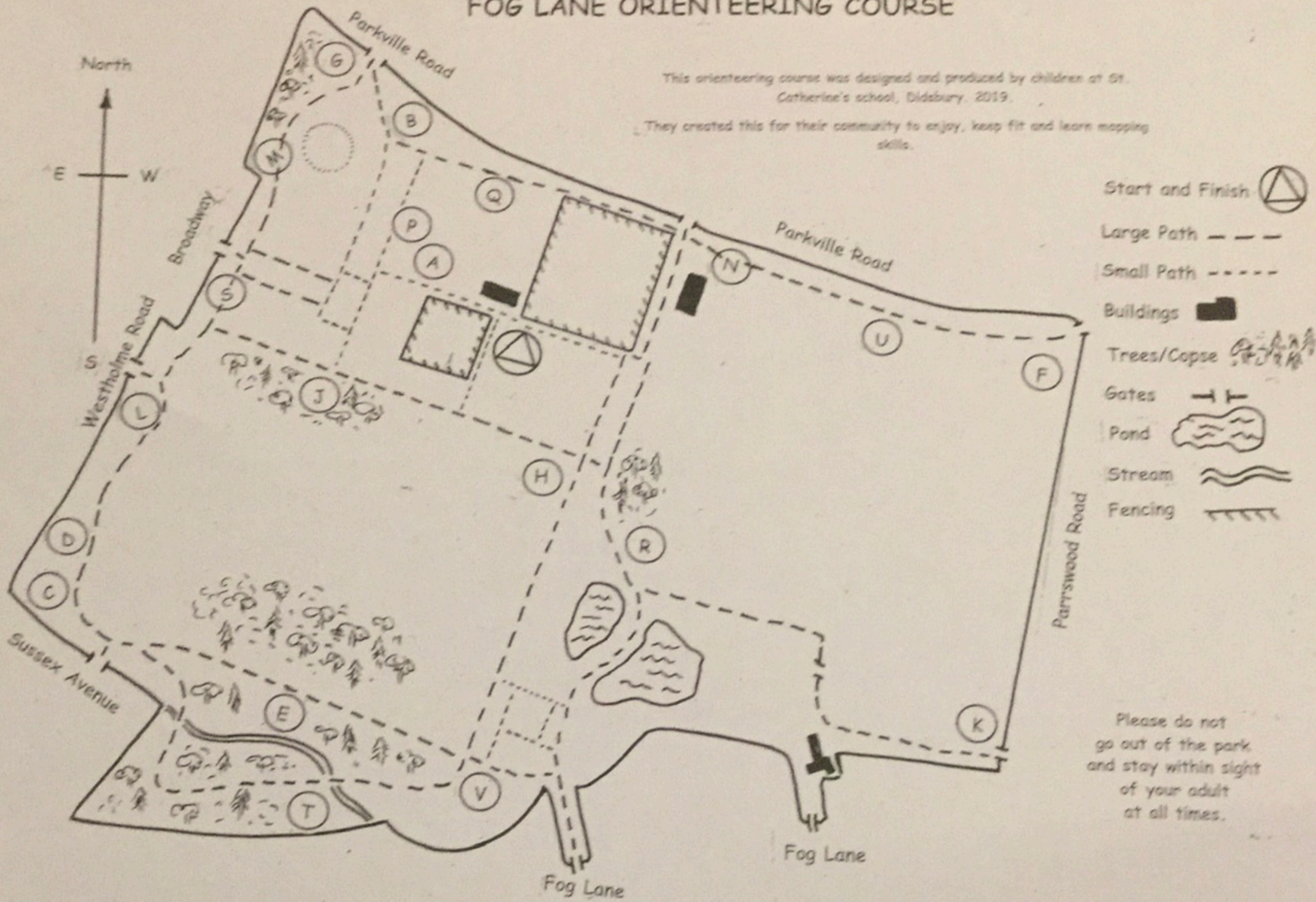


FOG LANE ORIENTEERING COURSE

Orienteering at Fog Lane Park

Your aim is to find all the control markers in Fog Lane Park.

The markers are timber posts, each with a letter and a symbol on them. The letters on the markers correspond with the letters on the map and the symbol is copied on to the control card, to record your visit.

No previous orienteering skills are needed, you can enjoy strolling around or set yourself a time target to complete the course.

The course can be enjoyed alone or by families and groups and is wheelchair friendly.

The start and finish of the course is denoted by  and the markers can be visited in any order.

A compass may be useful, but not
necessary.
